Clearly not phased by the obvious warning sign. I did see two other small pocket slides yesterday also in new snow on bed surfaces of older slides. Also got some wind slabs to break but no propagation. General snowpack is getting very deep now but a thick junk layer remains at the ground everywhere I dug sleds out.

Otherwise phenomenal riding conditions, everything high and north facing was all time!
