Looking for instability

We rode into Teepee Basin first. We had perfect visibility and saw no avalanches. We dug on the far north ridge on a south facing slope: HS 105, ECTN25 on facets about 40 cm off the ground. There is a lack of recent ava activity and ECTN score, which point towards a snowpack trending towards <u>stability</u>, but the snowpack structure is still suspect: facets underlying a <u>slab</u>.

Next we rode to a small and recent avalanche in Cabin Creek. We were alerted to it last night. Although it was steep and wind-loaded, it illustrated the lurking problem we are finding in most areas. <u>Faceted snow</u> is not entirely trusted. We did not see evidence of avalanches on Skyline ridge and folks are starting to climb.
