We skinned up the east face of the Throne and dug at the top of the east face (8100 ft, east <u>aspect</u>) and again on the north facing slope at top of the throne itself (8300 ft, north <u>aspect</u>). Snow depth of ~7 ft on the east face and ~4 on the north. ECTX in both pits. No cracking, collapsing, or other signs of instability. No avalanches observed. Little wind effect in the new snow. South aspects starting to get a surface crust, no crust on east or north.
